Planning your future after yr 11

Year 11 students will all have a careers interview The last few years must have felt very strange as we went through the pandemic and your education was disrupted. However, things have been getting back to normal and now you must plan for your future.

You may not realise it, but you will all come out stronger, more resilient, and more open to different opportunities than previous groups of students. Sixth Form College Apprenticeships

You have 3 main options - INVESTIGATE ALL 3

- continue your education at sixth form (or a college).
- start an apprenticeship probably intermediate 2 or 3 advanced.
- take a study and vocational course combined.

ADVICE & GUIDANCE – In year 11 you have a careers interview with a qualified careers adviser to discuss your ideas and help you plan for leaving school.
